Tournament Rules

A cheque payable to "Clifford Minor Hockey" must accompany the application to be eligible for entry into the various tournaments. The tournament will be filled on a first come, first served basis, and entry will be only accepted upon receipt of the cheque and application. **The cheque will be cashed after the date of the tournament.** Cheques received for those applying after the tournament is filled, shall be returned after the tournament. (These teams will be placed on a waiting list in order of the date received, in case of late cancellations by eligible teams).

Each team is guaranteed two games, except the Cricket Tournament which are guaranteed three games.

PLAYER CARDS AND APPROVED TEAM ROSTERS MUST BE PRESENTED UPON ARRIVAL FOR THE FIRST GAME. The cards or list will be returned after your last game.

CRICKET TOURNAMENT WILL BE OPEN TO ALL CENTRES. REP TOURNAMENTS ARE 8 TEAMS - C, CC, D, DD There will be body checking for the Bantam Boys teams.

Admission for the Cricket Tournament is \$4 per game, or \$10 for a weekend pass.

All other C.M.H. tournaments have no admission fees.

GAME PLAY RULES

O.M.H.A. rules apply to all games.

All referees decisions are final.

All teams are to be ready ½ hour before game time.

Fighting, game misconduct, gross misconduct and match penalties will result in immediate expulsion for the remainder of the tournament.

The games will be decided by sudden death overtime, with each team starting with a goalie and 4 skaters for 2 minutes, then 3 skaters for 2 minutes, then 2 skaters for 2 minutes. Any penalties will result in a penalty shot. In the event a player is hurt, a change is allowed, but the injured player cannot play the remainder of the overtime. A player whose penalty carries into overtime must serve their time. If still tied, there will be a sudden death shoot-out, using 3 shooters. (Example: if team A's first shooter scores and team B's shooter does not score, the team A will win the game). If still tied 3 different shooters will shoot-out.

During overtime, a player must change while play is in progress, not at a stoppage of play (unless injured).

Championship games and consolation championship games - if tied after regular play it will be decided by 10 minutes sudden death overtime periods.

If winning team is ahead by 5 or more goals in the last 10 minutes of play, straight time will be played.
